1. Introduction: As an element of providing foundational support, THSAA is pleased to be able to award one or more scholarships of \$1,000 or more to a Tumwater High School (THS) graduating senior(s) who are pursuing a degree from an accredited post-secondary education (2 or 4 year) institution.
2. Eligibility: A graduating senior who has applied and plans to attend an accredited institution following graduation from THS.
3. THSAA encourages any Tumwater High senior to submit an application. We especially encourage persons attending *Running Start* or similar programs to submit this application and include his/her activities at THS, the other school, or outside of school. In the essay, declare and/or explain your reasons for attending Running Start.
4. Selection Criteria: Academic achievement, leadership experience, community activities and extracurricular activities, essay and faculty recommendations will be considered in determining the scholarship recipient(s).

NOTE: Applications that do not follow these instructions or are incomplete will not be considered.

5. Selection Process:
 - a. Applicants shall complete and submit the THSAA Scholarship Application Form (attachment A) to: THSAA Scholarship, P.O. Box 14114, Tumwater WA 98511. Applications must be postmarked by Friday, **March 29, 2024**.
 - b. Or submit the application to Ms. Deana Rueda at the THS Career Counseling office THS by Friday, **March 29, 2024** by 11:00am.
 - c. Or submit the application by email to thsaa.scholarship@gmail.com by **April 2, 2024**. See the instructions at Submission Checklist.
 - d. The application **must** be typewritten.
 - e. The selection panel may elect to interview the finalists using a standard set of questions. The interviews will be completed as soon as possible.
 - f. The finalist(s) will be selected within one week after conclusion of any interviews and be notified in writing.
6. Selection Panel will consist of multiple THSAA members. A panel member will remove him/herself from the selection process if a family member is a scholarship applicant.

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7. The THSAA Treasurer will write a check to the scholarship recipient upon notification of enrollment.
8. At the commencement of fall classes at the college, the THSAA Treasurer will verify enrollment of the scholarship recipient.

 - g. If you are submitting the application by email to thsaa.scholarship@gmail.com, attach each file to the email. Put your name in the subject line of the email and in the name of each attached file.
